### **Dr. Christoph Sutter**

Christoph has been working on CDM related issues since 1997 and has been a member of the UN CDM Executive Board Methodology Panel for several years.

Before co-founding South Pole he was a consultant and carbon finance expert with McKinsey & Company. He holds a Ph.D. in environmental sciences, having written his thesis on CDM sustainability assessment methodologies. The World Economic Forum (WEF) selected Christoph as a Young Global Leader 2009. Christoph is the CEO of South Pole.

### **Renat Heuberger**

Renat has been working exclusively on the carbon market since 2001. At South Pole he has coordinated the setup of local presences in China, Taiwan, Indonesia, Mexico, and South Africa, and has originated several million CERs and VERs worldwide.

Before joining South Pole he was a co-founder and managing director of myclimate.org, a world leader in voluntary carbon offsets. He has worked on numerous assignments for international donors such as GTZ, UNIDO, and the World Bank. Renat was a finalist of the Swiss Social Entrepreneur Awards 2005. At South Pole Renat is in charge of global operations and new business development.

### **Ingo Puhl**

Ingo has over 14 years experience in climate change policy and market mechanisms.

Before joining South Pole he was the managing director of 500 PPM, one of the pioneering companies in the carbon market. Prior to founding 500 PPM he was working for several international institutions such as the World Bank and the International Energy Agency.

At South Pole Ingo is responsible for strategic growth initiatives.

### **Guido Schmidt-Traub**

Prior to joining South Pole Guido led the MDG Support team in UNDP's Bureau for Development Policy, and he was also the Associate Director of the UN Millennium Project. Guido was a Partner at IndexIT Scandinavia, a strategic advisor for technology companies and managed a private investment fund for early-stage European technology companies. Guido is currently a climate change advisor to the Africa Progress Panel chaired by Kofi Annan and is an Associate Fellow at Chatham House (UK). Guido is the Director for Strategic Partnerships for South Pole.

### **Alberto Carillo Pineda**

Alberto draws from a wide field of experience in the environmental sector. His knowledge covers oil production and various kinds of plastics, SF<sub>6</sub>, recycling, and wastewater treatment. Alberto holds two master's degrees, including an Oxford University Master of Science in Environmental Change and Management. With his involvement, South Pole was able to source over six million tCO<sub>2</sub>e in six countries. At South Pole Alberto is the Country Manager Mexico.
